06-521	Partially opened cylinder restricts SCBA use.
06-476	No SCBA used on vehicle fire.
06-389	Face mask knocked off firefighter's face resulting in smoke inhalation.
06-385	Firefighter exposed to natural gas @ leak; SCBA worn, not used.
06-358	Possible exposure to anhydrous ammonia without respiratory protection.
06-307	Improper level of protection worn in IDLH environment.
06-282	Captain remains within structure after low air alarm is sounded. Firefighter runs out of air when he ignores low air alarm while fighting fire and searching for lost child.
06-279	Daily SCBA inspection is critical.
06-228	SCBA use neglected in interior fire attack.
06-227	Failure to fully open bottle results in loss of air.
06-226	Failure to open SCBA cylinder completely and poor facepiece seal result in inhalation injury.
06-166	Fire officer runs out of air after missing low air alarm sounding; hit by collapse while exiting.
06-155	SCBA use necessary on every fire.
06-114	Properly working SCBA fails suddenly during interior attack.
06-081	Car fire flashes over during search of passenger compartment. Catches firefighter leaning in.
06-072	Improper levels of protective clothing worn at a natural gas leak.
05-685	SCBA air line fails during low profile drill.
05-606	Crew becomes disoriented during search of a basement.
05-597	Firefighter operating inside a burning structure without an SCBA.
05-596	Low oxygen level found in MRI Room.
05-559	Out of air emergency on second floor of a residential structure
05-557	A combination of new equipment, SCBA system & turn-out gear, young officer, and a mixed crew.
05-496	Crew inhales chlorine gas during odor investigation.
05-480	Out of air emergency on operating apartment fire.
05-478	Regulator pops off facepiece during entry.
05-278	Instructor works passed air supply. Mayday results.
05-186	SCBA fails during overhaul.
05-178	Instructor runs out of air.
05-172	Out of air, removed facepiece in IDLH.
05-066	Air bottle shut off on me as I fell thru a weak floor in structure.
